Students whose applications are accepted will be inducted into the National Junior Honor Society in October. Members are required to uphold high academic standards, as well as provide service to their school and local community. Each member who completes a total of 15 community service hours during their 8th grade school year will be recognized in May at Academic Awards Night. Service hours can be completed independently; however, service opportunities are also provided by the advisors throughout the school year.
