## **ATTENTION PARENTS**

### **Southern Regional Middle School and High School Students**

If you suspect that your child has an educational disability and they are a student at Southern Regional School, you can call the Southern Regional Child Study Team or Ocean County Supervisor of Child Study teams for guidance. The numbers are listed below.

### **What happens if you call the Ocean County Child Study Team office?**

You will talk to the County Supervisor of Child Study Team who is knowledgeable about special education and related services. The County Supervisor will refer you to the Supervisor of Special Services at Southern Regional.

### **What happens when you call Southern Regional?**

You will talk to the Supervisor of Special Services who is also knowledgeable about special education and related services. He will likely refer you to one of the district's Child Study Team members who will clearly outline the Child Study Team referral process and answer any questions you may have.

### **Making a request for services.**

If you would like to request an evaluation for special education and related services and your child is a Southern Regional School District student, send a written request to Southern Regional School District's Supervisor of Special Services. Include your child's name, address, date of birth, and a list of perceived education difficulties. After receiving your letter, the Child Study Team has twenty (20) days to meet with you. At this meeting, you and the team will decide if an evaluation is needed and what the evaluation will include.

To the greatest extent possible, students with disabilities will receive their education in classes with students who are not disabled.
