Marking Period 1

Topics/Units to be covered:

- How does Spanish sound?
- How do we communicate our needs in Spanish class?
- How would we introduce ourselves in Spanish? Name, age, origin, likes/dislikes
- Where is Spanish spoken? Spanish speaking countries
- How do we describe ourselves and others? Description, nationality.
- Grammar concepts: noun/adjective agreement and placement, definite/indefinite articles in singular, irregular verb ser

Marking Period 2

Topics/Units to be covered:

- How do we describe our school life? Classes, friends, school supplies, teachers.
- How do we discuss what we wear? Regular verbs, clothing, colors
- Grammar concepts: adjective agreement in plural form, regular ar/er/ir verbs, direct and indirect articles in plural form, continue irregular verb ser in plural forms
- Quarterly

Marking Period 3

Topics/Units to be covered:

- What do we do during a school day? Time, how we get to and from school, clubs and activities
- What do we eat? Likes and dislikes, meals and foods, eating in a restaurant, shopping for food
- Grammar concepts: the verb gustar, and irregulars ir (ir+a+infinitive), dar, estar,
- Quarterly

Marking Period 4

Topics/Units to be covered:

- What do families look like? Family members, where do families live, descriptions
- What sports are played in the world? Sports, body parts
- Grammar concepts: stem-changing present tense verbs, possessive adjectives, tener and tener que, estar, gustar, interesar, aburrir
