Tentative Itinerary

Day 1: Depart for Europe

Day 2: Munich touring, including altes Rathaus, Marienplatz, Viktualienmarkt and Residenz Palace

Day 3: Tour the BMW Museum and Olympic Stadium; tour of Dachau concentration camp; Nymphenburg Palace (time allowing); travel to Garmisch-Partenkirchen

Day 4: Cogwheel train to Zugspitze peak, then cable ride down; scenic Lake Eibsee; Fussen area to visit the spectacular Newshwanstein Castle built by Mad King Ludwig (and inspiration for Cinderella's Castle at Disney's Magic Kingdom!); return to Garmisch

Day 5: Oberammergau with visit to Passion Play house; visit to site of 1936 Winter Olympic Games with hike up the incredible Partnachlam gorge (weather permitting); afternoon visit to Innsbruck for city tour and guided visit to Innsbruck Schloss Ambras or Hofburg Palace; depart for Salzburg

Day 6: Salzburg Cathedral; Mozartplatz; Hallein Salt Mines

Day 7: Tour of Hahensalzburg Fortress; pass through the Austrian Alps en route to Vienna; walking tour of the city; evening visit to Prater amusement park

Day 8: Stephansplatz and Michaelerplatz; St. Stephen's Cathedral; stroll through Heldenplatz and Naschmarkt; optional visit to Mozart's home; Schonbrunn Palace; depart for Munich in late afternoon
