Dear Members of the Class of 2023, Parents/Guardians:

The Southern Regional School District is pleased to announce the Class of 2023 Southern Regional Local Scholarship Program. This unique program, offered to every member of the senior class, has helped many of our graduates continue their education at some of the best colleges, universities, and post-secondary schools in the country. Last year, the Class of 2022 was awarded \$882,660. in local scholarships. These awards were presented to 297 members of the class by 312 donor organizations. This amount is over and above the scholarships awarded by colleges, universities, and national endowment programs. Our local community supports the efforts of our students in a way that other communities cannot imagine. We are extremely proud to offer this program for our students and value it greatly.

All members of the Southern Regional Class of 2023 are eligible to apply for this program. To be considered for a scholarship, students must complete the online scholarship application that will be available online starting December 9. The application deadline is January 31 at 5:00 p.m. In order to be fair to all participants, there will be no extensions to this deadline.

Enclosed are instructions for completing and submitting the online local scholarship application. Additionally, an informational broadcast will air on SNN (Channel 21) from December 9 through January 31. This broadcast includes detailed information about the local scholarship program and provides instructions to complete the online application. Approximately 90% of the donor organizations select the award recipient/s based on their own unique criteria. Some donor organizations require additional information (essays, transcripts, etc.) from students. Students must regularly review the list of local scholarships on our website to determine if additional information is required. A school committee that is populated by teachers, guidance counselors and school administrators select the remaining 10% of the scholarship appointments.

Directions: Students must follow the instructions below to complete the scholarship application. Please note that this application is not mobile friendly. Parents are encouraged to review the completed application.

1. Go to www.srsd.net
2. Go to **Guidance** tab and select **Scholarships**
3. Click **Scholarship Application**
4. Click **Apply Now**
5. Students logging in from home will need to log in using District credentials
 - a. Username: southern\first letter of first name all of last name and the last 2 digits of your graduation year

EXAMPLE: southern\chenry23
 - b. Password: the password you use to log into the district computer system
6. Enter the five digit student ID
7. Enter student's birth date and click Submit
8. Verify information and click yes
9. Enter the five digit student ID
10. Enter the last 4 numbers of your phone number (must match the primary phone number listed for the student in Genesis) and click Submit
11. Complete the application
12. All fields marked with a ***red asterisk*** must be completed for the form to be submitted
13. Students and parents will receive an email confirmation when the application is completed
14. Students may update the scholarship application using the directions above

Please note: Some scholarships require additional information (essays, transcripts, etc.). Scholarship lists and requirements are updated often. Students **MUST** regularly review the list of local scholarships on our website to determine if additional information is required.
