5467- Scholarship Program Eligibility

The Board of Education acknowledges the usefulness of a system of determining eligibility criteria for students who choose to apply for scholarship consideration in the local scholarship program.

The Board authorizes scholarship program eligibility to be based upon the length of enrollment in the district and enrollment in courses that are listed in the program of study and that that meet on campus.

To be considered eligible for application to the local scholarship program a student must be enrolled in the district for one full year in accordance with Policy 5111.

To qualify for scholarship eligibility a student must complete a minimum of 15 credits from courses listed the program of study during the senior year in accordance with Policies 2230 and 5120.

Students who are not eligible, as per the preceding paragraph, but who participate in an extra-curricular activity and/or an interscholastic athletic activity are eligible for scholarships that are specific to, and sponsored by, the extra-curricular activity and/or interscholastic athletic activity that she or he participated in.
