### Please DO NOT BUY one large binder AND USE IT for all classes!!

#### LANGUAGE ARTS & LANGUAGE ARTS LAB: (supplies will be shared between classes)

- One 1 1/2" binder with lined paper

- 2 highlighters (any color)

#### MATH:

#### **PHYSICAL EDUCATION:**
