Riptides Supply List Materials for Success

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Please do not combine subjects into large binders. Your teachers specifically request ONE BINDER PER SUBJECT.

ENGLISH:

- One three-ring binder, 1 to 1 1/2 " wide, with paper
- Five notebook dividers
- One black/white marble composition book
- One 1-subject spiral notebook
- Post-It Notes, several color highlighters, and glue sticks (1)
- Pens, pencils and 3 red pens

ENGLISH LAB:

- One three-ring binder, 1/2 " wide, with paper
- Pencils
- 6 highlighters (6 different colors)

MATH:

- One three-ring binder, 1 inch wide, with lots of paper (for class work & homework)
- One-subject spiral notebook w/ three holes to be placed inside the binder (the larger-8.5/11 inch long is best)
- Pencils ONLY (lots)
- 2 glue sticks for pasting notes into your spiral notebook

MATH LAB:

- One black/white marble composition book
- Durable folder
- Lots of pencils

SOCIAL STUDIES:

- One three-ring binder, 1 to 1 1/2" wide, with paper
- Pens and pencils
