TEST PREP RESOURCES

> NJGPA

What is it? The NJGPA is a New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment given in 11th grade. It consists of an ELA and Mathematics component and students must reach the cut off score of 725 to be eligible for graduation. Students who do not reach this score may retake the test senior year. Students who do not reach the required score on the NJGPA may demonstrate proficiency on another test (see below) to satisfy the standardized test graduation requirement.

> PSAT/SAT

What is it? The PSAT is essentially a practice SAT. 11th graders who take the PSAT and score well may qualify for the National Merit Scholarship. The PSAT is not used for college admissions, however, students who do not pass the NJGPA in grade 11, may use their PSAT results to potentially satisfy the NJ standardized test graduation requirement.

The SAT is multiple choice test used to determine college readiness. Many colleges use the SAT as part of the admissions process since it provides a common data point that can be used to compare all applicants. Students who do not pass the NJGPA in grade 11, may use their SAT results to potentially satisfy the NJ standardized test graduation requirement.

Both the PSAT and SAT are created by the College Board and given at Southern Regional for students who sign up. The PSAT is given in October, free of charge. The SAT is given on multiple dates https://satsuite.collegeboard.org/sat/registration/dates-deadlines and comes with a cost.

> ACT

What is it? The ACT is a standardized test used for college admissions in the United States. This test is not administered at Southern, but you can register here: http://www.actstudent.org/regist/

> ACCUPLACER

What is it? The Accuplacer is an online test that community colleges frequently use for placement. The test is designed to assess student readiness for introductory credit-bearing courses. Students who take the Accuplacer at Southern Regional will receive their results at the conclusion of the test.

Students who do not pass the NJGPA in grade 11, may use their ACCUPLACER results to potentially satisfy the NJ standardized test graduation requirement.

> ASVAB

What is it? The ASVAB (or Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery test) is a standardized test that reveals areas of strength and ability in science, math, and language. It is primarily used for entrance into the Armed Forces. *Please note*: The New Jersey Department of Education no longer accepts ASVAB results as a standardized test graduation requirement.
