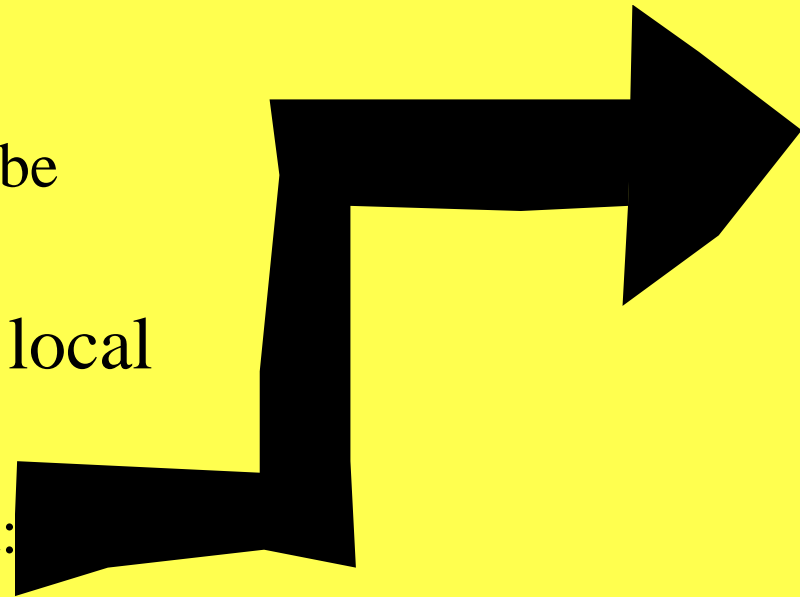

 - The **online** application will not be accessible after January 31st.
- Periodically review the list of local scholarships to:
 - Determine what else is required:
 - Applications
 - Essay
 - Transcripts

During the 2017-2018 school year, the Southern Regional School Community responded by offering our graduating seniors \$585,312.00 in gifts and scholarships.

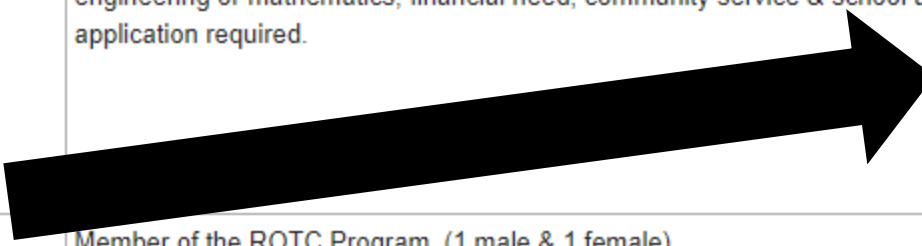

This list is added to and updated weekly so it is important that you continue to monitor this list throughout the remainder of your senior year. If there is any additional paperwork that you need for these scholarships there will be a direct link provided or the materials will be available in the HS Guidance Office.

To be eligible for the local scholarships, the "first step" is to complete the online local scholarship application. The online application will be posted at this location for the class of 2018 from December 11, 2017 thru January 31, 2018 at 5 p.m.

Completing and [submitting \(online\)](#) the Local Scholarship Application is all that is necessary to be eligible for 75 percent of the local scholarships. The remaining local scholarships require additional information such as an essay or an additional application. It is important that you review the local scholarship list to determine if there are additional scholarships that you may be eligible for if you complete the local donor's requested information.

Step Two Deadlines

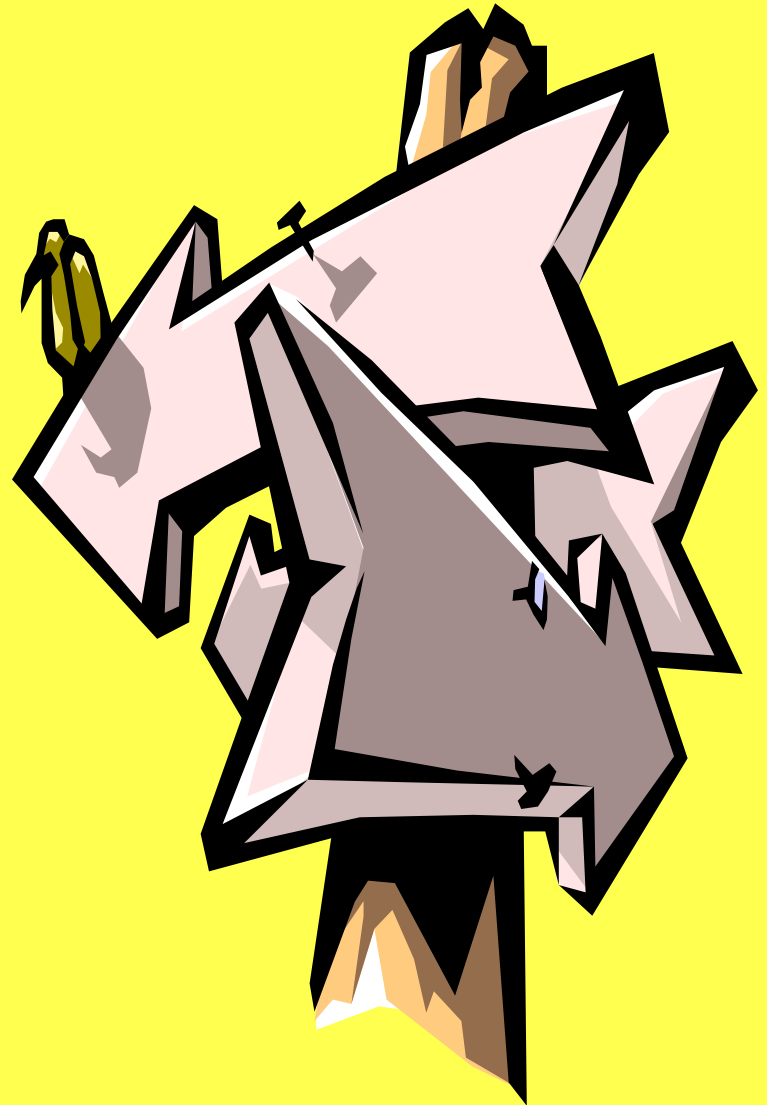
Each scholarship has a deadline by which information specific to that scholarship is due.

Decisions

- Eighty-five percent of the donor organizations determine the recipient/s
- A Southern Regional High School Scholarship Committee determines the remaining 15% based on the donors' criteria.



How do you find out if you have been awarded a scholarship?

- Letters get sent home in the second week of May
 - Informing you that you have been selected as a scholarship/s recipient but, not informing you as to which scholarship/s you have received.
 - Inviting you to the **Scholarship Award Ceremony which is Thursday, May 31, 2018** in the 11-12 Gymnasium beginning at 6:00 p.m.
